Parking Restrictions on Moreland Avenue

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Moreland Avenue between Delaware Avenue and Robert Street is scheduled for reconstruction in 2021. The new design adds sidewalk within the right-of-way and provides a consistent parking lane for much of the corridor. With these changes come new parking restrictions. The following sections of Moreland Avenue will need to be posted *No Parking* in order to comply with the new design:

- Both sides between Delaware Avenue and Robert Street
- South side from Smith Avenue to 295 feet west of Robert Street centerline
- North side from 85 feet east of Gorman Avenue centerline to Robert Street

Attached is map showing the parking restrictions.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Moreland Avenue is on the City's State Aid roadway system. The Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) requires a no parking resolution prior to approving the plans and allowing for the use of state aid funds to construct the roadway.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that City Council approve the attached resolution establishing parking restrictions on Moreland Avenue between Delaware Avenue and Robert Street.
