ORDINANCE NO. 21-006

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING WEST ST. PAUL CHARTER SECTION 1.06
INCREASING MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENT FROM 11 TO 13 MEMBERS**

The City of West St. Paul does ordain:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. West St. Paul City Charter Section 1.06 is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 1.06. Charter Commission Membership. The Commission shall be composed of ~~eleven~~ thirteen (~~11~~13) qualified voters of the City who have been appointed as provided by law.

SECTION 2. SUMMARY PUBLICATION. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Section 412.191, in the case of a lengthy ordinance, a summary may be published. While a copy of the entire ordinance is available without cost at the office of the City Clerk, the following summary is approved by the City Council and shall be published in lieu of publishing the entire ordinance:

The ordinance increases the number of Charter Commission Members from eleven to thirteen.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
