Consultant Contract for 2022 Sanitary Sewer Lining Project CP 22-4

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

In order to combat Inflow and Infiltration (I/I) and maintain structural integrity of our sanitary sewer mainline pipes, a cured-in-place piping (CIPP) project is typically done each year. The 2022 project is targeting all 8-inch sanitary sewer to make it more equitable by only requiring one pipe liner size. This project proposes to line about 2,700 feet of some of the worst 8-inch mainline sanitary pipe as follows:

Marthaler Ln.	Wentworth Ave.	Lothenbach Ave.
Sperl St.	Emerson Ave.	Moreland Cir.
Teresa Dr.	Richard Cir.	West end of road

FISCAL IMPACT:

Staff negotiated with Bolton & Menk, Inc. on a contract amount of \$14,070 to provide design, bidding and minor construction support services. Bolton & Menk has successfully performed these same tasks on past CIPP lining projects for the City. City staff will perform construction inspection/administration of the contract.

The 2022 CIPP lining budget is \$120,000 and funding would come from the Sanitary Sewer Fund.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council approve a contract with Bolton & Menk, Inc. for the 2022 Sanitary Sewer Lining Project, City Project 22-4, for the not to exceed contract amount of \$14,070.
