Joint Powers Agreement with St. Paul for the Annapolis Street Reconstruction Project 23-1

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The 2023 and 2024 Capital Improvements Program identifies Annapolis Street from Smith Avenue to Kansas Street to be reconstructed. Annapolis is a border street with St. Paul and therefore this is a joint project, but West St. Paul will be the lead agency. Based on the size of this two-year construction project it is important to start the design at this time. Attached is a Joint Power Agreement (JPA) with St. Paul to define cost sharing, roles and responsibilities. The JPA was reviewed by staff and the City Attorney and is recommended for approval.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Per the attached JPA, each city will pay for the construction costs in their city, except West St. Paul will pay 100% for the cost of Annapolis Street between Charlton Street and Bidwell Street.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that City Council approve a Joint Powers Agreement with St. Paul for construction and administration of the Annapolis Street Reconstruction Project 23-1.
