Approve a contract with Bolton & Menk for the 2023 Mill and Overlay Project, CP 23-3, for a not to exceed amount of \$75,861.	
Background	
As part of the effort for pavement preservation, 3.6 miles of residential streets are proposed to be milled and overlaid in 2023. This is a cost effective way to extend the life of the roadway. This project will follow the 429 Special Assessment Process. A public informational meeting will be held this summer for all affected property owners.	
Staff received three proposals from engineering firms, and evaluated them based on project understanding, project team and cost. Bolton & Menk had the lowest overall cost with a solid understanding of the project.
