**RESOLUTION DELARING ITEMS AS SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING DISPOSAL**

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department has four vehicles that were obtained through DUI Enforcement activities and the owners through the civil forfeiture proceedings lost their interest in the vehicles and the City now has title to the vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department is requesting to dispose of the following vehicles by sale of said vehicles at auction with funds being deposited into the DUI forfeiture account:
