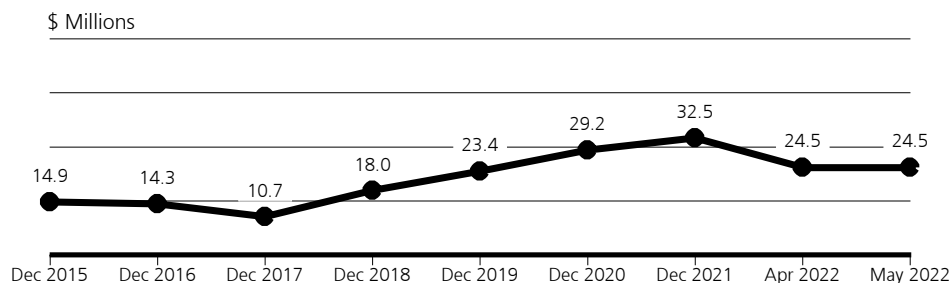

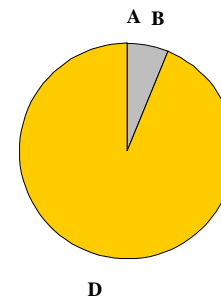

Money market funds
