Thursday, August 11

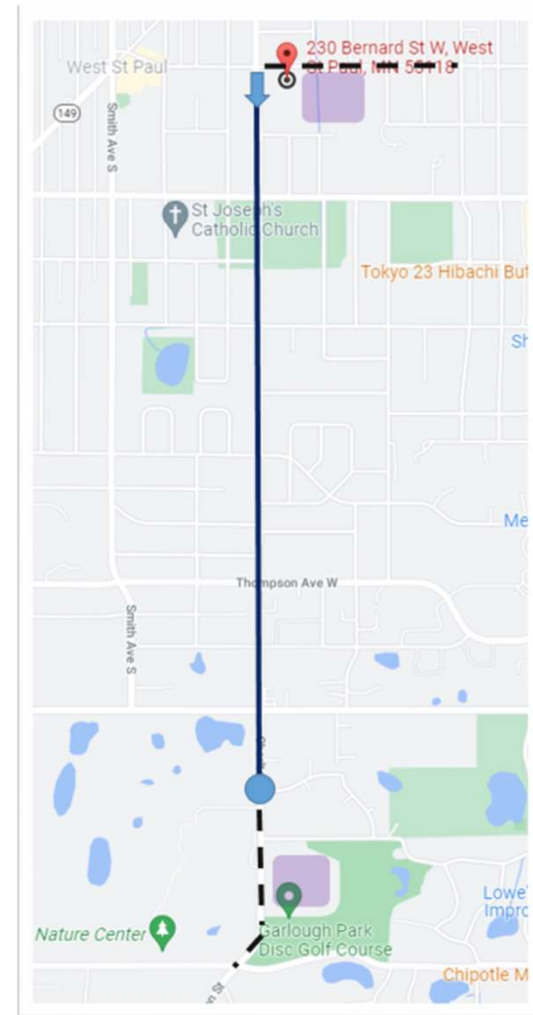
- Open House – 5:00-8:00 pm at South Metro Fire Station 1
