Approve plans and specifications and authorize ad for bid for the Annapolis Street Reconstruction Project, City Project 23-1.	
Background	
<p>The Engineering Department and our consultant, Kimley Horn, Inc. have completed the plans and specifications for the Annapolis Street Reconstruction Project. This is a joint project with the City of St. Paul and will include two years of construction. In 2023, Annapolis Street will be reconstructed from Smith Avenue to Robert Street, and in 2024 from Robert Street to Kansas Avenue. This project will add dedicated bicycle lanes between Smith Avenue and Oakdale Avenue, and fill in missing concrete sidewalk gaps on both sides of the street. The intersection of Annapolis/Charlton/Dodd will also see improvements.</p> <p>This prevailing wage project will be formally advertised with a bid date of February 16, 2023. Depending on St. Paul approval, the bid date may change slightly. West St. Paul is the lead agency for this project.</p>
