RESOLUTION NO. 23-

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of West St. Paul has an interest in advancing and advocating for legislative approval of certain legislative priorities during the 2023 legislative session.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the West St. Paul City Council that staff and City Council Members may actively advocate for and on behalf of the entire City Council on the following legislative priorities:

- Exemption from the TIF blight requirement for the former YMCA site, and
- Capital funding in an amount of at least \$2,496,000 for the design and construction of replacements for Lift Station 4 and Forcemain 4, and
- Payments from the State in any form for the purposes of refunding the City for Robert Street capital expenses.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City Council broadly supports the policy positions and priorities of the League of Minnesota Cities and Metro Cities.
