Action

Award bid for the Sanitary Sewer Forcemain 6 Project, City Project 22-3, to Northdale Construction Company, Inc., in the amount of \$853,942.52.

Background

Sanitary sewer forcemain 6 (FM 6) was originally installed in 1956 and then extended in 1966. This pipe runs under Smith Avenue, from Ruby Drive to Butler Avenue. A pressure rated liner will be installed in the existing pipe. During installation of the liner, the sewage will be bypassed. The intersection of Butler Avenue and Smith Avenue will be closed for approximately one week to replace deep sanitary sewer structures.

On February 28, 2023, bids were opened for the Sanitary Sewer Forcemain 6 Project. Three prevailing wage bids were submitted. The bids are shown below along with the engineer's estimate.

Contractor	Base Bid
Northdale Construction Co., Inc.	\$853,942.52
Minger Construction Company	\$883,168.00
Bituminous Roadways, Inc.	\$889,754.50
Engineer's Estimate	\$870,000.00

Northdale Construction Company, Inc. is the lowest responsible bidder. Northdale will perform all of the work except the lining itself which will be subcontracted to a company that specializes in lining pressure pipes. Our engineering consultant, Bolton & Menk, Inc. and city staff recommend that Northdale be awarded the contract.
