Action	
City staff is requesting Council hold a public hearing and approve the final reading of an ordinance amending the city code regarding stormwater management.	
Background	
Based on changes to our Municipal Separated Storm Sewer System (MS4) permit and the Lower Mississippi River Water Management Organization (LMRWMO) watershed management plan, the stormwater section of our City Code needs to be updated. In addition to updating the code, staff is also recommending to remove the stormwater language from the zoning section of the code and create a new section, Chapter 154, of the code specifically for stormwater management. This is similar to the existing format of the code, as building regulations (chapter 150), floodplain management (chapter 151), and parkland dedication (chapter 152) are their own respective chapters within the code.
