Approve a contract with Corrective Asphalt Materials for \$56,306.99.	
Background	
<p>Since 2021, the city has moved away from chip sealing as a preventative maintenance tool for newer asphalt. We have been using an asphalt rejuvenator instead, as have a growing number of other cities in the metro. The properties of this product extend the life of the asphalt by increasing its durability, flexibility and resistance to weather. In addition, the cost per square yard is less than traditional chip seal.</p> <p>This year we are applying rejuvenator to Moreland Avenue between Delaware Avenue and Robert Street, which was a 2021 street reconstruct. We have also added the Marie Avenue bicycle trail (Robert Street to Oakdale Avenue), the parking lot at the Sports Complex, and the asphalt trails that run through Harmon Park and the Sports Complex. Work is expected to occur in July.</p>
