RESOLUTION ACCEPTING DONATIONS TO THE CITY

WHEREAS, the below listed individuals/organizations have donated funds to the City;

St. George Antiochian Orthodox Church – As the Council is aware, St. George’s Church holds an annual festival every year whereby residents and others can gather for fun, food and music. While this is a fundraiser for the church, they recognize the efforts of others in helping their festival be a success, especially the Police Officers and volunteers who help and stop by during the event. As such, St. George’s Church is donating \$1,000 to the Police Department to use towards outreach activities. Police Chief Bud Shaver thanks the church for their generosity and states the funds will be put to good use.
