ORDINANCE NO. 19-12

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 133.01 (F) OF THE WEST ST. PAUL CITY
CODE REGARDING REFUSE HAULING AND RECYCLING COLLECTION**

The City of West Saint Paul does ordain:

SECTION 1. West St. Paul City Code Section 133.01 (F) relating to Refuse Hauling and Recycling Collection is hereby amended as follows:

(F) *Refuse hauling and recycling collection.* Between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and ~~7~~6:00 a.m. on any weekday, and between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m. on any weekend or holiday, no person shall collect or remove garbage or recyclables in a residential zoning district or any commercial or industrial district that is located within 500 feet of a residential zoning district.

SECTION 2. SUMMARY PUBLICATION. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Section 412.191, in the case of a lengthy ordinance, a summary may be published. While a copy of the entire ordinance is available without cost at the office of the City Clerk, the following summary is approved by the City Council and shall be published in lieu of publishing the entire ordinance:

This section is amended to allow refuse hauling and recycling collection to begin at 6:00 a.m. instead of 7:00 a.m.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
