**RESOLUTION NO. 20-**

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE  
THOMPSON/OAKDALE FEASIBILITY STUDY**

**WHEREAS**, the City of West St. Paul applied for and received a grant for the amount of \$30,000 from the Minnesota State Health Improvements Program (SHIO) through the Dakota County Active Living partnership to develop a bicycle and pedestrian feasibility study along sections of Thompson and Oakdale Avenues; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the study was to determine the preferred bicycle and/or pedestrian infrastructure improvements, create 30 percent preliminary engineering plans, and provide preliminary cost estimates; and

**WHEREAS**, the City entered into a contract with Kimley Horn on January 13, 2020 for the preparation of the study; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 11, 2020, the West St. Paul Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee reviewed the segments and provided feedback; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 24, 2020, the West St. Paul City Council reviewed the segments and provided preliminary feedback; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 5, 2020, the City of West St. Paul held a public open house to gather public comment for the study; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 10, 2020, the West St. Paul Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee reviewed a draft of the plan and supported the approval of the plan; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 23, 2020, the West St. Paul City Council reviewed a draft of the plan and were satisfied with the progress of the study; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 8, 2020, the West St. Paul City Council reviewed the final draft and recommendations of the study; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that that West St. Paul City Council hereby accepts the Thompson/Oakdale Bicycle and Pedestrian Feasibility Study dated May, 2020;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the study will serve as a framework for future bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure improvements along the specified segments as deemed appropriate by the City Council.
