TUMBLING & GYMNASTICS

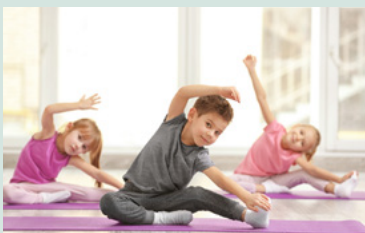


**Child & Adult Tumbling | Saturdays, March 12- April 30 | 2:30-3:00pm | Ages 18 Mos. – 2

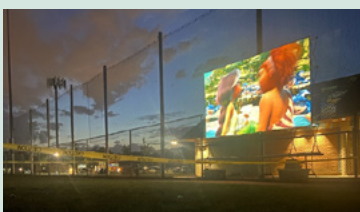
